
DEFERRED APPLICATIONS BEFORE THE BOARD

Pursuant to Section 19(2) of the NT Building Act 1993, the Building Appeals Board has determined that the following policy will apply in relation to all applications for modification to the requirements of the Building Regulations submitted to the Building Appeals Board -

1. On consideration of an application, should the Board require further, or additional, information in order to make a determination, the Board will defer consideration of the application to the next Board meeting.
2. The applicant will be informed in writing of the Board's request for further information and will be asked to provide the information prior to the date of the next Board meeting.
3. Should the requested information or a response outlining any extenuating circumstances on why the requested information is unable to be provided, not be submitted within 8 weeks from date of notification, the application will be determined at the next scheduled Board meeting based on the merit of the application as originally submitted.
