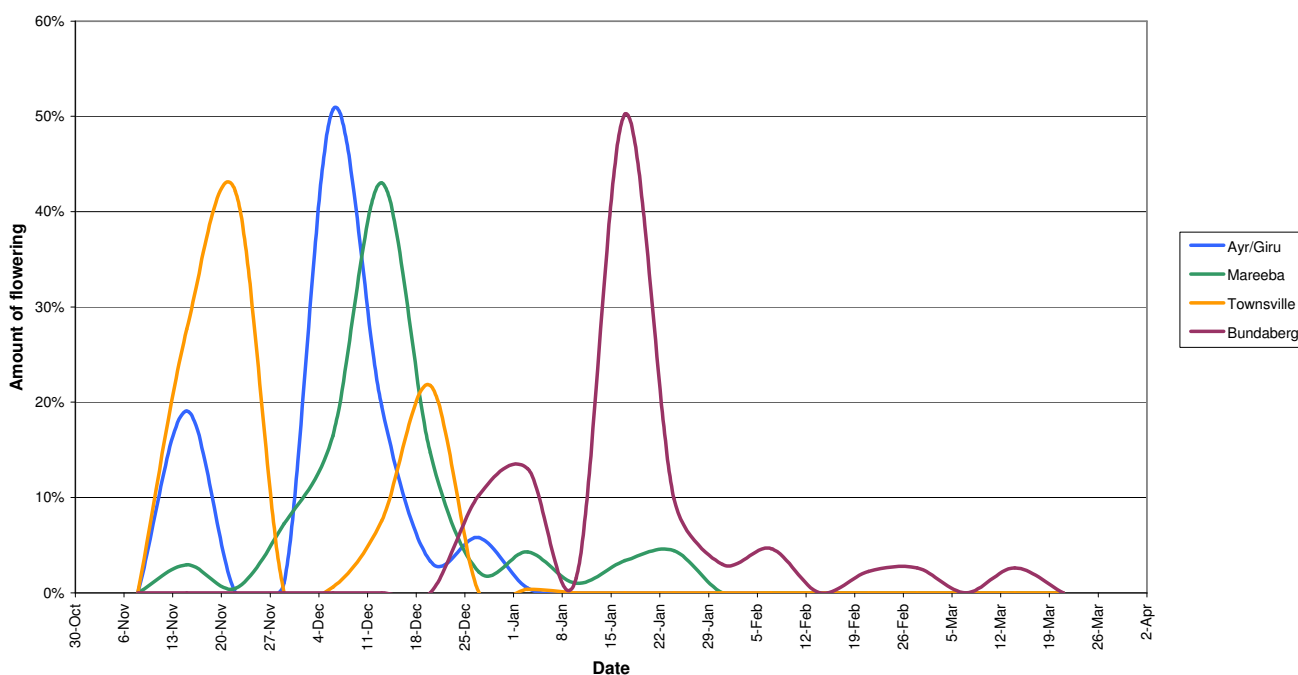

- There is a significant amount of overlap between mid December and January.

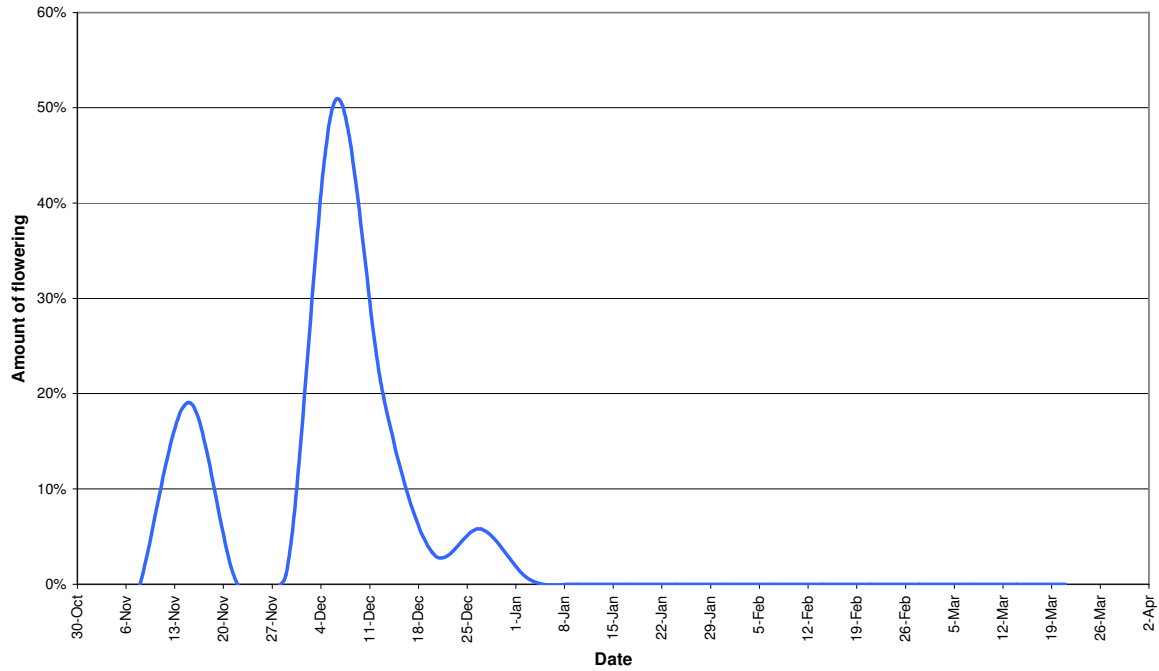

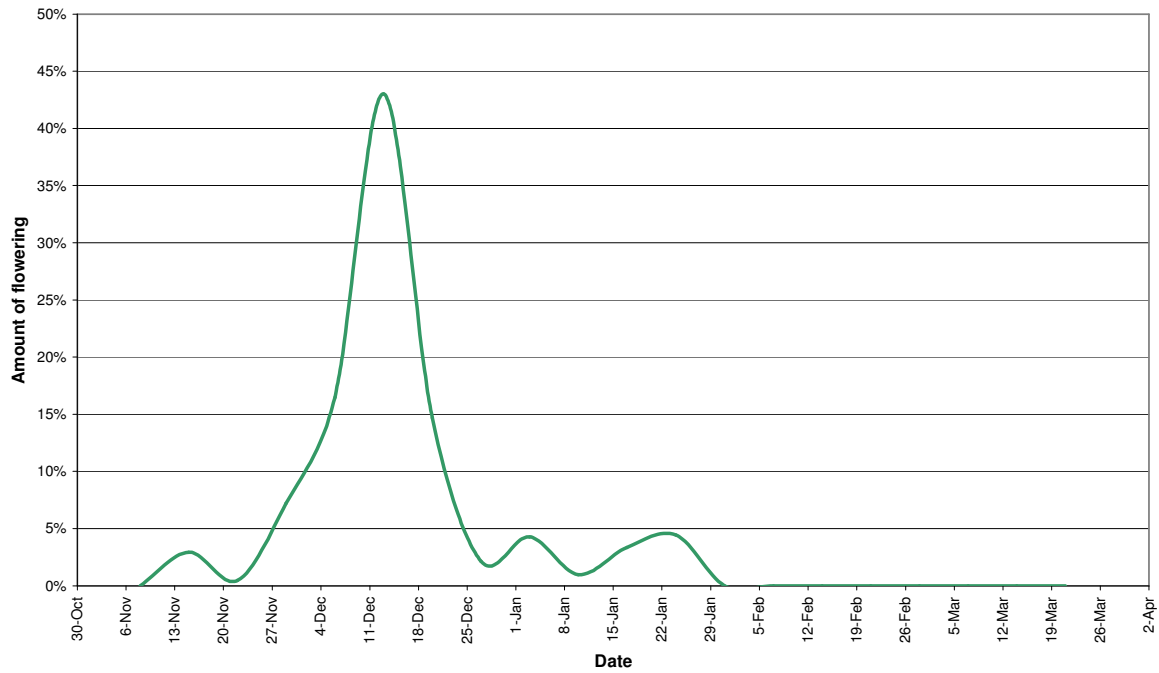

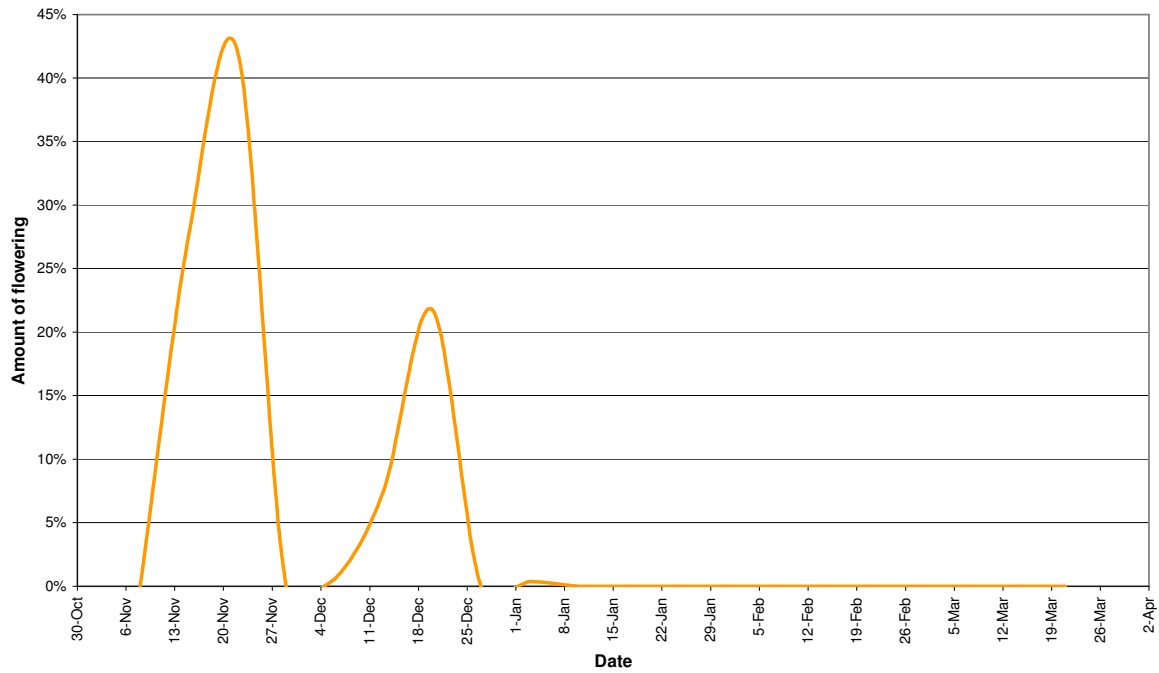
**QLD Mango Crop Forecast (Mareeba)
