Site Folders

incoming folder – public account can dump files here but cannot list the contents for confidentiality and security reasons.

outgoing folder – public account can list and grab all files here but cannot add or delete.

Instructions for accessing the FTP site

1. Download and install ftp software and follow their instructions for connecting

Recommend **filezilla** <http://filezilla-project.org/> or **fireftp** (a Mozilla firefox addon) to connect to the server. Both are available as free downloads over the web.

Password: ntgsquest

2. use Internet Explorer (not recommended)

Go to web address <ftp://kakadu.nt.gov.au/outgoing>

You'll be prompted for a username and password

username is : meicguest

password is: ntgsguest

- 2.1 Ensure that Internet Explorer's ftp setting is set to Passive.

Set this by Tools > Internet Options,
then click the Advanced tab, and turn on:

- Enable folder view for FTP sites
- Use Passive FTP

Troubleshooting

1. Your ip address. You can get this from <http://www.whatsmyip.org/>
2. The time of connection attempt. Exactly, to the minute if possible.
3. The software or browser you're using to connect.
