

**SUGGESTED PARTICULARS TO BE INCLUDED IN NOTIFICATIONS BY  
EL APPLICANTS TO AFFECTED LANDOWNERS/OCCUPIERS**

Brief history of applicant.

- when incorporated or when operations commenced;
- other areas of interest (mines and prospects);
- number of people employed;
- number of shareholders.

Reason EL sought.

- what mineral(s) sought.

Plan of EL.

- Indicate boundaries of EL in relation to boundaries of each affected landowner.

Define mineral(s) sought.

- occurrences;
- Physical features.

What particular area is sought.

- layman's description of reasons for likely occurrence and potential targets.

Requirement for mineral(s) sought.

- market demands;
- other sources;
- economic and social development for NT;
- preferred production time-frame.

Exploration Techniques.

- aerial survey;
- creek and soil sampling;
- drilling;
- costeaning;
- no substantial disturbance without prior approval of the Chief Executive Officer of the Department of Regional Development, Primary Industry, Fisheries and Resources Development (after consultation with landowner – compliance with "Code of Conduct").

Rights and obligations of Licensee.

- exploration only;
- term of licence;
- restrictions;
- compensation;
- subsequent mining tenure – agreement required from private landowner.

Rights of Landowners

- lawful activities not disturbed;
- may object to grant of EL within 30 days of notice of application appearing in the NT News, or lodge comments to the Department of Regional Development, Primary Industry, Fisheries and Resources for consideration of excising area or attaching specific performance conditions to the licence.

Liaison.

- exchange contact names, addresses and telephone numbers.
