

A Quick Guide to the New 1080 Baiting Arrangements in the NT - 2

- 1- **Dry Manufactured 1080 Baits are now available for use in the NT in addition to the 1080 wet meat baiting service offered by NRETAS.**
- 2- **After September 1 a landholder wishing to conduct a baiting program on their property with either Fresh Meat or Dry Manufactured Baits must obtain the following -**
 - A. *'Approval to purchase a 1080 Product and Conduct a baiting Program'*
 - and**
 - B. *'Permit to Take Protected Wildlife -1080 Pest Animal Control'*
- 3- **The actual collection and laying of the baits must be done by a person holding a:**
 - C. *'1080 User Authorisation'*

NB. This may or may not be the landholder.
- 4- A strictly controlled number of persons in addition to NRETAS staff will be Authorised to produce and supply fresh meat baits under stringent conditions and subject to regular audits. Contact Chemical Services Section DRDPIFR for details.
- 5- **Where to send applications;**
 - A. *'Approval to purchase a 1080 Product and Conduct a baiting Program'-
Apply to RDPIFR Chemical Services – Valid for up to 2years.*
 - B. *'Permit to Take Protected Wildlife -1080 Pest Animal Control' –
Apply to NRETAS Permits Section – Valid for up to 3 months.*
 - C. *'1080 User Authorisation'- **Apply to RDPIFR Chemical Services-**
Valid for up to 5 years*
