Agricultural and Veterinary Chemicals (Control of Use) Act

**APPROVAL TO PURCHASE A 1080 CHEMICAL PRODUCT AND CONDUCT A
1080 BAITING PROGRAM**

I, JOHN ALCOCK, Chemicals Coordinator, in pursuance of section 49 of the *Agricultural and Veterinary Chemicals (Control of Use) Act*, and Part 4 of the Regulations being satisfied that Applicant has sufficient reason to possess a **sodium monofluoroacetate (1080) chemical product** that is a Schedule 7 Restricted Chemical Product, authorise them to purchase the chemical product specified in this document for pest animal control on the following Property/ies; Name of Station/Property, subject to the conditions that the holder of this approval:

- (a) Observes all relevant instructions in the '**Directions for Use of 1080 for Pest Animal Control**'.
- (b) Observes all of the conditions as laid out in each of the individual Permits to Take Protected Wildlife 1080 Pest Animal Control as issued by Department of Natural Resources, Environment, The Arts and Sport (NRETAS) from time to time during the period of this Approval.
- (c) Bait laying is to be carried out only during the times as laid out in each of the individual Permits to Take Protected Wildlife 1080 Pest Animal Control as issued by NRETAS from time to time during the period of this Approval.
- (d) Ground or aerial application of baits is permitted by this approval in accordance with the specific conditions contained in the current Permit to Take Protected Wildlife 1080 Pest Animal Control as issued by Department of Natural Resources, Environment, The Arts and Sport (NRETAS) as in force from time to time during the period of this approval.
- (e) The holder of this approval must provide for locked secure storage (both on property and in the vehicle used for transport). The 1080 chemical product must, except when in actual use by the Authorised 1080 Users be stored in the locked secure storage area.
- (f) The Nominated and Authorised 1080 User must record each usage of the 1080 chemical product in accord with the Regulations to the Act. The holder of this approval must ensure that all records of use, neighbour notification and installation of signage are held securely for 2 years.
- (g) The Department of Regional Development, Primary Industry, Fisheries and Resources (DRDPiFR), Chemicals Coordinator must be notified as soon as possible if baits are lost or cannot be accounted for.

- (h) Bait handling, including purchase and laying, must only be performed by the Authorised 1080 Users listed on the individual Permits to Take Protected Wildlife 1080 Pest Animal Control as issued by NRETAS from time to time during the period of this Approval.
- (i) This approval will need to be presented to the 1080 bait supplier along with the relevant Permit to Take Protected Wildlife 1080 Pest Animal Control as issued by NRETAS plus the individual's 1080 User Authorisation plus photo ID by the nominated person before they can collect the 1080 baits.
- (j) The holder of this Approval must advise the Chemicals Coordinator, DRDPFR immediately of any material change in circumstances that changes the risk associated with the conduct of the baiting program from that which existed at the commencement of this approval.
- (k) This approval expires on **DATE**.
