

Notes for Retailers selling 1080 Products

Background

1080 Products are both an S7 product and a Restricted Chemical Product (RCP).

The normal S7 requirements apply plus several additional steps as a third party may be handling and applying the baits.

1. A Landholder must hold a current **'Approval to Purchase a 1080 Chemical Product and Conduct a 1080 Baiting Program'** as issued by RDPIFR Chemical Services. This is current for 2 years.
2. Any person who will be handling or laying baits must hold a current **'1080 User Authorisation'**.
3. A **'Permit to Take Protected Wildlife - 1080 Pest Animal Control'** is required to be obtained by the landholder prior to purchase and use 1080 products. On this permit are listed the following -
 - i. The details of the landholder and property where it is proposed to use the baits.
 - ii. Persons Authorised to handle baits (this includes collecting them from you). This person need not be the landholder who arranged the purchase but must be the holder of an **'1080 User Authorisation'**.
 - iii. Number and type of baits to be used.
 - iv. Dates of the baiting period. This is usually issued for 3 months.
 - v. Approval Number for the **'Approval to Purchase a 1080 Chemical Product' and Conduct a 1080 Baiting Program'** as issued by RDPIFR Chemical Services'
4. Any person collecting baits from you must hold a current **'1080 User Authorisation'** as issued by RDPIFR Chemical Services and be listed on the **'Permit to Take Protected Wildlife - 1080 Pest Animal Control'** above.

Retailer requirements to hold and sell 1080 products

Retailer must hold a current **Licence to Sell or Supply Poisons with Sodium Fluoroacetate [1080] endorsed on the licence**. This licence is issued by Dept. Health & Families – Poisons Control – under the *Poisons & Dangerous Drugs Act*. (Ph 8922 7341).

Purchase and Collection Procedures

1. Landholder or owner contacts retailer to order 1080 product.
Things the retailer needs to know –
 - (a) Does the landholder hold a current '**Approval to Purchase a 1080 Chemical Product' and Conduct a 1080 Baiting Program**' as issued by RDPIFR Chemical Services.
 - (b) Has the landholder applied for a '**Permit to Take Protected Wildlife - 1080 Pest Animal Control**'. This prescribes how many baits he can purchase.
 - (c) Does the landholder have persons with 1080 User Authorisations organised to handle the baits. If he does not no one can pick them up.

2. A person comes to collect the baits (or you deliver them – note special transport conditions) -
This person **must** have the following:
 - '**Permit to Take Protected Wildlife - 1080 Pest Animal Control**'
 - '**1080 User Authorisation**'
 - **Photo ID**
 - '**Approval to Purchase a 1080 Chemical Product and Conduct a 1080 Baiting Program**' – This would have been supplied and recorded in your records at the time of ordering.

3. Retailer is to make records at the time of collection as described below.

Records to be kept by retailer

These records will be kept on the forms supplied and as required under Section 46 of the *Poisons and Dangerous Drugs Act*.

It should include copies or details of the following -

- *Permit to Take Protected Wildlife-1080 Pest Animal Control*'
- '*1080 User Authorisation*'
- '*Approval to purchase a 1080 Chemical Product and Conduct a 1080 Baiting Program*'
- *Details of person collecting 1080 Product*
