Schedule 3: Terms, conditions and limitations to which permit is subject.

- Methods of take of wildlife specified in Schedule 1 are limited to:
Incidental impact from authorised 1080 baiting program *
- The wildlife specified in schedule 1 may only be taken from the area/s specified in Schedule 2.
Incidental impact from authorised 1080 baiting program *
- This permit shall remain in force until the date of expiry, unless cancelled by the Director of Parks and Wildlife pursuant to Section 59 of the Territory Parks and Wildlife Conservation Act. *
- The handling and distribution of 1080 baits on the subject land shall only be in accordance with the conditions of this permit, the associated Agricultural and Veterinary Chemicals (Control of Use) Act authorisations and the Directions for use of 1080 for pest animal control. *
- The permit holder shall ensure that only suitably qualified and authorised persons access, handle, distribute and retrieve 1080 baits. *
- The permit holder must obtain the authorisation of those persons who will be employed or otherwise engaged in activities on behalf of the permit holder under this permit. The permit holder and nominees shall keep a copy of this permit in their possession at all times when engaged in the activity for which this permit is issued and shall produce it for inspection by a Conservation Officer upon request to do so. Only the permit holder and nominees listed on this permit are to engage in the activities authorised by this permit. *
- The permit holder shall immediately report any incident of suspected or confirmed non-target species animal deaths or poisoning to the Department of Natural Resources, Environment, the Arts and Sport Permits Office by telephone 08 8999 4795 or facsimile on 08 8999 4524 or email pwpermits.nretas@nt.gov.au *
- At the completion of the permit period, the permit holder shall submit a return on the approved 1080 Baiting Operations Diary provided by the Department of Regional Development, Primary Industries, Fisheries and Resources to the Department of Natural Resources, Environment, the Arts and Sport Permits Office which will include baiting dates, target locations, the number of baits laid and the number and type of observed deaths (if any). *
- The permit holder shall notify the Director of Parks and Wildlife, or their delegate, of any change of address within twenty one (21) days of the address changing. *
- Pursuant to section 64 of the Territory Parks and Wildlife Conservation Act, a person who is aggrieved by a decision made under this Part may, not later than 30 days after the date of the decision, appeal against the decision to the local court. A decision that is the subject of an appeal continues to have effect according to its tenor during the conduct of the appeal. *

This permit allows for a limited baiting program using a maximum of INSERT NUMBER 1080 (Sodium Monofluoroacetate) manufactured dry meat baits.
