Incident Report Form

Spray Drift Affecting Agricultural Produce

Spray drift that affects agricultural produce will be investigated by the Department of Primary Industry, Fisheries and Mines (DPIFM). Reports that are of an urgent nature will be taken by telephone but a written report of the incident is required.

Description of alleged incident (include, date, time, location, product name, active ingredient, produce or land affected).

Person or Company alleged to be applying the chemical (provide as much detail as possible).

Witnesses (Name/address/telephone number).

Name of any other Agency informed (eg: Work Health Authority, Dept. Health & Community Services, Dept. Natural Resources, Environment and the Arts).

Method of Application of the chemical (ground, air etc).
