

## Mango Crop Forecast – 11 November 2009

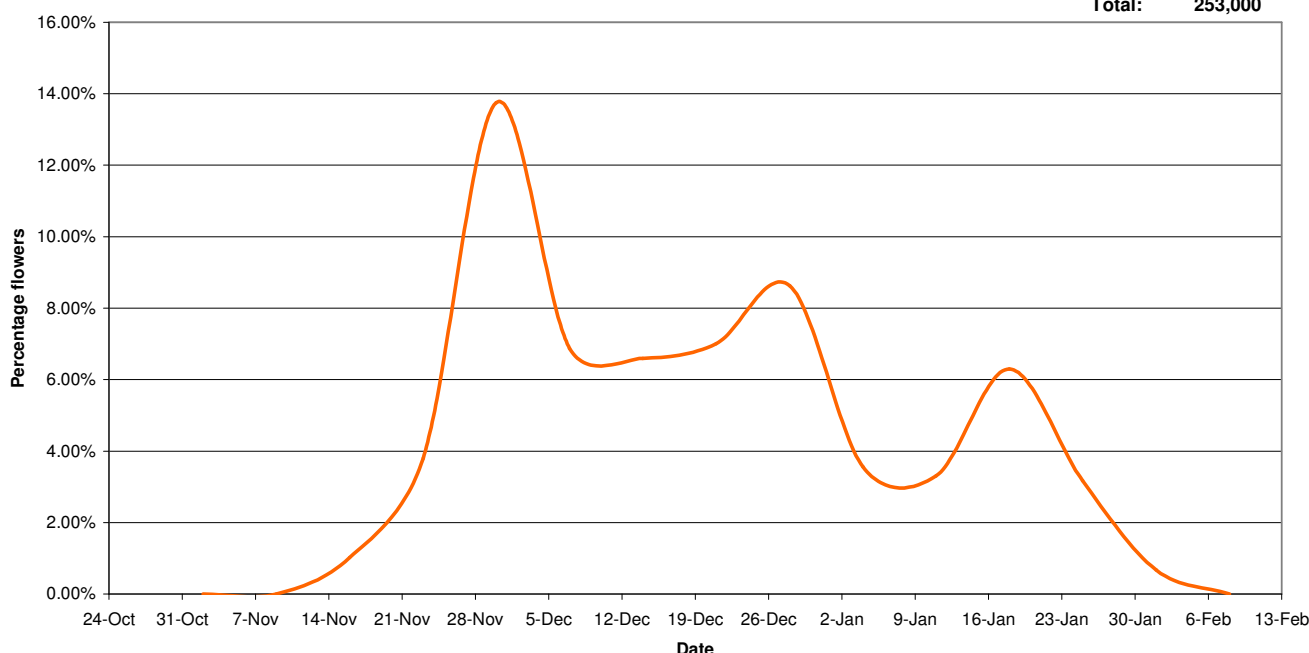
### NT Key Points:

- The Darwin season is coming to an end with most sheds finished.
- There was a significant amount of fruit drop, particularly in Katherine- related to hotter than normal August temperatures.
- The Katherine season is in full swing.

### 2009 Crop Forecast Queensland

#### Tree counts:

Townsville	63,400
Giru & Ayr	75,800
Mareeba	42,840
Dimbulah	19,190
Bundaberg	52,008
<b>Total:</b>	<b>253,000</b>



\*Percentage flowers: where timing of flowering indicates timing of harvest and is indicative of production peaks but is not volume.

### Key Points:

- The season has shifted by 4- 7 days earlier based on current Bureau of Meteorology temperature data (see following graph for regional plots).
- The main season will run from late November through to January.
