SUBJECT: PIPELINES ADRIFT – SOUTH OF CAPE GREY – SHIPPING HAZARD

Reports of 10 or more pipelines, measuring approximately 20 metres in length are currently drifting West North West about 18 nautical miles South of Cape Grey.

The last reported coordinates of these pipes were approximately 13° 15.496'S 136 ° 44.137'E

Due to the size of the pipes, they represent a hazard to shipping. All vessels in this area are advised to be on the look out and to report any sightings to **Coast Radio Darwin** on **VHF Ch. 16, HF 4125, 6215, 8291** or call **S/C Constable Natasha Wood** at **Alyangula Police Station** on **8987 6122**.
