SUBJECT: BOATING HAZARD – SUNKEN YACHT

All vessels transiting the waters in the vicinity of the Darwin Sailing Club, are asked to be aware that a seven metre, blue hulled, with white deck, has been reported to have sunk approximately 800 metres from shore.

An orange marker buoy has been placed on the mast of the sunken vessel. At low tide the mast is just visible under the surface.

All vessels are asked to avoid this water hazard and pass at a safe speed.
