## Update on Barkly Highway

Monday, 26 January 2009

Dispatched at 4.15pm CST

Only vehicles less than 4.5 tonnes - including those towing caravans and trailers – are being allowed to cross the reconstructed section of the Barkly Highway.

An assessment of the condition of the road will be made tomorrow. This follows recent storm-generated rains in the region. Trucks will be allowed to cross when it safe for them to do so.

The regulatory times for the movement of traffic will continue to be enforced. West bound traffic is allowed one way access from 6am to 11.30am Northern Territory time. East bound traffic is allowed one way access from 12.30pm to 5pm Northern Territory time.

No travel is allowed outside these times.

Traffic controllers will continue be stationed at the Barkly Homestead, Camooweal, and at the work site.

Motorists are asked to travel slowly and exercise extreme care when travelling through the work site.

Motorists are being urged to refer to the Department's Road Report website before travelling on the Barkly, and across all roads in the Territory, to receive updated road condition information on all Government-controlled roads, including graphical representations of restrictions on regional maps.
