

## Water over Victoria River Bridge

The Victoria Highway at the Victoria River Bridge - 200 km west of Katherine – is still closed to traffic.

Water is now 2.3m above the deck of the bridge and is rising slowly. The bridge is likely to remain closed for several days.

The gates to the bridge have been shut and locked. Message boards in Kununurra and Katherine have been altered to alert motorists to the closure, and will be updated to reflect changes to travel conditions.

Due to the water saturation of the Victoria Highway, weight restrictions are still imposed on trucks travelling from the NT/WA border to Katherine. Motorists should exercise caution at submerged floodways and stream crossings.

An assessment of the repaired section of the Carpentaria Highway - 170 km east of the Stuart Highway - has been made. Water saturation of the road has postponed lifting restrictions to the movement of oversized vehicles at the site.

The condition of the road will be re-assessed tomorrow. Light vehicles and standard-sized trucks are continuing to pass.
