



Water over Victoria River Bridge

Sunday, 25 January 2009

Issued at 4.42pm CST

The Victoria Highway is still closed at the Victoria River Bridge 200 km west of Katherine. The water level is now 2.5m over the bridge and rising at the rate of 75mm an hour.

Variable message boards have been set up in Kununurra and Katherine advising travellers of the closure. The bridge may be shut for several days. The gates on the approach to the bridge have been locked.

The Department's road report website, and the message boards, will be updated as conditions change. People driving to the bridge will be turned back.

Due to the saturation of the Victoria Highway, weight restrictions have been imposed on trucks travelling from the NT/WA border to Timber Creek.

Temporary repair work on the eroded section of the Carpentaria Highway at October Creek, 170 km east of the Stuart Highway, has been completed. Light vehicles and standard-sized trucks may pass.

Oversized trucks are being halted in the vicinity until repairs have been assessed on Tuesday 27 January 2009.
