General Information:	<p>The program is an opportunity to develop skills and qualities such as communication, teamwork, motivation, leadership and self-confidence.</p> <p>The program is managed by the Young Endeavour Youth Scheme and operated by the Royal Australian Navy. The STS Young Endeavour was a bicentennial gift from the United Kingdom and was dedicated by the Prime Minister for 'the benefit of the young people of Australia'.</p> <p>Participation in the Young Endeavour's sail training program, accommodation and meals, personal accident, liability and baggage insurance, a Young Endeavour kitbag and crew shirt, loan of wet weather gear, sailing smock and safety equipment are included in the program fee. Travel costs to and from the ship are not included.</p>



Youth Development Programs

To be eligible to apply to the program, you have to be an Australian citizen or permanent resident, aged between 16 and 23 years of age on the day of departure of the voyage, be able to swim 50 metres and be in good health (a health evaluation must be completed by a medical practitioner). Selection is by ballot, held once each year.

A limited number of berths is allocated to Community organisations, which may nominate and sponsor a young person, bypassing the ballot selection process.
