Girraween Road Re-alignment

Roadwork to re-align Girraween Road near Coolalinga will commence Monday 21 September 2009. Works are intended to improve traffic flow and safety in the area and will take around four months.

This \$2.4M project comprises of:

- Changing the intersection of the Stuart Highway and Henning Road to provide a dedicated left turn lane onto the Stuart Highway.
- Re-aligning Girraween Road and providing improved access for heavy vehicles to the Stuart Highway access road at Coolalinga.
- Closing the existing intersection of the Stuart Highway and Girraween Road which requires motorists to cross two lanes of the highway.

The works will make it safer for traffic turning to and from Girraween Road. Motorists will no longer be required to use the median intersection near the existing entrance to Girraween Road. Upon completion of the project access to Girraween Road will be located near the Stuart Highway service road at Coolalinga.

In conjunction with the re-alignment, the Department is also finalising the design for a 'Park and Ride' public transport facility to be located adjacent to this project. This is taking place as part of the extension of public transport services to the rural area.

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
