



Arnhem Highway

Road works

Pavement upgrade works will commence on the Arnhem Highway on **Tuesday 16 August**.

The road works will take place at 1km west of Mt Bundy Creek (approx 62kms from Stuart Highway) and include strengthening and lifting the existing roadway.

These works are part of a Territory Government \$5M commitment this financial year to upgrade parts of the Arnhem Highway.

Scope of works

Over the next two months, pavement strengthening at various locations will take place between at:

1. Adelaide River Floodplain from the Adelaide River Bridge east for approx 4kms.
2. 12 flood ways at various locations between 38km and 77kms.
3. Between 62km to 63km

All road users should be aware that delays may be experienced when travelling on the Arnhem Highway while the works are taking place.

Traffic management will be present at each location and motorists are advised to heed all traffic devices and speed limits in place around the road works.
