



Tiger Brennan Drive Duplication - Dinah Beach update

Scope of work

The Territory Government has begun construction of the duplication of Tiger Brennan Drive between Woolner and Dinah Beach Roads. Included in this project are improvements to the intersection of Gonzales Road and Tiger Brennan Drive.

Comprising of two stages, the project will significantly enhance road safety by reducing traffic congestion.

Stage one

Earthworks and drainage for the new inbound lanes (between Gonzales and Woolner Roads) is already underway, and due for completion in July 2011. Work on this part of the project will cease at the end of current works to allow for settlement of the road embankment in preparation for stage two.

Stage two

The full duplication of Tiger Brennan Drive (between Woolner and Dinah Beach Roads) will commence in approximately 12 months.

Environmental assessment

A thorough environmental assessment has been undertaken on this project with strict controls in place to protect the mangroves and harbour.

Impacts during construction

There may be speed restrictions and lane closures in place around the works. Motorists are urged to heed all traffic advices and speed limits.
