



# McMinn Street Duplication

## Project Update - April 2011

Road works are continuing on the construction of the outbound lanes on McMinn Street from the McMinn Street/Frances Bay Drive roundabout to the McMinn Street/Bennett Street/Tiger Brennan intersection. Works will take approximately 6 weeks.

### Scope of works

Works involve the construction of the outbound lanes on McMinn Street from the McMinn Street/Frances Bay Drive roundabout to the McMinn Street/Bennett Street/Tiger Brennan intersection.

### McMinn Street one-way only

From Wednesday 6 April, McMinn Street (from Tiger Brennan Drive to Frances Bay Drive) will be open to one-way traffic only.

If you live, work or visit the areas affected by the works (and you wish to access the central business district) you will need to use Kitchener Drive/Hughes Avenue.

If you are travelling to the northern suburbs/Palmerston/rural areas, you can use Frances Bay Drive and exit on Tiger Brennan Drive.

### Local residents

Residents on the section of McMinn Street affected by the road works will still be able to access their properties. Please follow the directional signage.

### Pedestrian access

For safety reasons, pedestrian access may be restricted. During this time, pedestrians will be escorted around the works.

Variable message boards and detour signs will be in place. Motorists are asked to heed all signs and advice during construction.
