ANTI-DISCRIMINATION ADS PROMOTE EQUAL OPPORTUNITY

Promoting equal opportunity and eliminating discrimination throughout the Territory are at the heart of a television advertising campaign launched yesterday at Parliament House by the NT Anti-Discrimination Commissioner Tony Fitzgerald and the Minister for Justice, Hon Syd Stirling MLA.

During the launch Commissioner Fitzgerald said that the Anti-Discrimination Commission aims to promote a culture that respects human rights and difference in all aspects of Territory life. "The ADC's vision of a fair, equal and inclusive NT underpins the advertising campaign."

Minister for Justice Syd Stirling said the ads would help to spread awareness about different forms of discrimination.

"The Territory is a unique multicultural place with people from diverse backgrounds and cultures," said Mr Stirling.

"It is especially important that we maintain the effort to promote equal opportunities for all Territorians, regardless of disability, race or gender."

"There is no excuse for discrimination in today's society – and I commend the Anti-Discrimination Commission for putting together such a worthwhile campaign."
