## REASONS FOR DECISION

### BACKGROUND

- 1) Inspector Peter Boyle, on behalf of the Director of Licensing made application on 2 April 2009 for the cancellation of the licence of Ms Collette Mann trading as C & C Catering from a premises at 3 Sedge Court, Karama.

### HEARING

- 2) At hearing Inspector Boyle advised the Commission that attempts to contact Ms Mann at her business address of 3 Sedge Court, Karama had been unsuccessful and the registered mail sent to that address had been returned.
- 3) The Commission was further advised that the Karama property had been sold with the new owners taking possession in 2008. This sale has been confirmed by Property Title Search.
- 4) Ms Mann was the only person who had an interest in the business trading as C & C Catering and all attempts to locate her have failed.

### DECISION

- 5) The Commission finds that the conditions laid out in Section 72(5)(a) of the *Liquor Act* have been met, that is that a licence may be cancelled where the Commission is satisfied that the premises has "not been used for the sale or supply of liquor for a period of ninety (90) days".

- 6) The Licence of Ms Collette Jeanne Mann trading as C & C Catering is therefore cancelled forthwith.
