Practice Direction No 2 of 2000

General Matters

As Chairperson of the Lands and Mining Tribunal, I make the following Practice Direction:

1. In the event of any party wishing to convene a hearing of the Tribunal for the legitimate ventilation of any issue, the provisions of Rule 9 of the Lands and Mining Tribunal Rules shall apply, with the necessary changes, save that if the convening of the Tribunal is in relation to a procedural matter, no affidavit as required in Rule 9(1)(c) shall be required.
2. No legal advice shall be sought from the Registrar, other staff or from any member of the Tribunal and none of those persons shall be permitted to volunteer to any party to an appeal any legal advice. For the purposes of clarification, issues relating to the procedures of the Tribunal are not deemed to constitute “legal advice”.
3. The office of the Registrar, where documents are to be lodged, is at the office of the Tribunal on the 3rd floor, 9-11 Cavenagh St, Darwin, NT.
4. A copy of the legislation, rules, practice directions and all forms are available from the office of the Registrar.
