

**LIQUOR ACT**

**2nd NOTICE OF APPLICATION FOR A LICENCE**

**TO SELL LIQUOR**

**CURVE RESTAURANT AND BAR, DARWIN WATERFRONT**

Medina Property Services Pty Ltd, HEREBY GIVE NOTICE that it has applied to the Northern Territory Licensing Commission for a "PUBLIC HOTEL" Liquor Licence to sell liquor from the premises to be known as CURVE RESTAURANT AND BAR, located at the Medina Grand Darwin Waterfront and Vibe Hotel Darwin Waterfront, Kitchener Drive, Darwin City.

The concept of the premises will be predominately that of a Restaurant and Alfresco Area with Bar facilities.

PROPOSED TRADING DETAILS for the sale of liquor are as follows:

- Liquor shall be sold at any time to bona fide lodgers of the premises or invited guests of the lodger, (in the presence of the lodger), for consumption on the premises.
- Liquor may be sold to the general public for consumption on the premises as follows:
  - From 10:00 hours to 23:00 hours without a meal; and
  - From 23:00 hours to 02:00 hours (the following day) only in conjunction with a meal.
- Light meals and snacks will be available for the duration of trading hours.
- The premises shall at all times have the appearance of and shall trade predominantly as a restaurant.
- Patrons to be seated at a table.

This is the second notice of application.

The objection period is deemed to commence from Friday, 14 November 2008.

Pursuant to Section 47F(2) of the *Liquor Act* an objection may only be made on the ground that the grant of the licence may or will adversely affect:

- (a) the amenity of the neighbourhood where the premises the subject of the application are or will be located; or
- (b) health, education, public safety or social conditions in the community.

Only those persons, organisations or groups described in Section 47F(3) of the *Liquor Act* may make an objection. Section 47G of the *Liquor Act* requires the Director of Licensing to inform the applicant of the substance of any objection. This will include the identity and where relevant the address of the objector.
