### 2nd NOTICE OF APPLICATION FOR A LICENCE

#### TO SELL LIQUOR

#### **MEDINA GRAND DARWIN WATERFRONT AND VIBE HOTEL DARWIN WATERFRONT**

Medina Property Services Pty Ltd, HEREBY GIVE NOTICE that it has applied to the Northern Territory Licensing Commission for a "PUBLIC HOTEL" Liquor Licence to sell liquor from the premises to be known as the Medina Grand Darwin Waterfront and Vibe Hotel Darwin Waterfront, Kitchener Drive, Darwin City.

The concept of the premises is to provide Mini Bar and Room Service, Licence four Function Rooms and provide consumption of Alcohol in the Pool Area.

PROPOSED TRADING DETAILS for the sale of liquor are as follows:

- supply of alcohol to lodgers and bona fide guests in the presence of lodgers by way of Mini Bar and Room Service.
- Liquor may be consumed by lodgers and bona fide guests in the presence of lodgers in the Pool Area.
- Liquor may be consumed by bona fide attendees at the four conference rooms and function breakout area identified on the first floor of the premises from 10:00 hours to 02:00 hours (the following day).

This is the second notice of application.

The objection period is deemed to commence from Friday, 14 November 2008.

Pursuant to Section 47F(2) of the *Liquor Act* an objection may only be made on the ground that the grant of the licence may or will adversely affect:

- (a) the amenity of the neighbourhood where the premises the subject of the application are or will be located; or
- (b) health, education, public safety or social conditions in the community.

Only those persons, organisations or groups described in Section 47F(3) of the *Liquor Act* may make an objection. Section 47G of the *Liquor Act* requires the Director of Licensing to inform the applicant of the substance of any objection. This will include the identity and where relevant the address of the objector.
