2nd NOTICE OF APPLICATION FOR A LICENCE

TO SELL LIQUOR

THE EAST WEST RESTAURANT

I, [Even Lynne on behalf of Knuckey Street Pty Ltd](#), HEREBY GIVE NOTICE that I have applied to the Northern Territory Licensing Commission for a [restaurant](#) Liquor Licence to sell liquor from the premises to be known as [The East West](#) Restaurant located at [43 Knuckey Street, Darwin](#).

PROPOSED TRADING DETAILS for the sale of liquor are as follows:

- The business proposed to be conducted on the premises will be in the nature of a restaurant for the sale and consumption of liquor ancillary to a meal.
- Liquor may be sold for consumption on the premises seven days a week between the hours of [11:30](#) and [02:00](#) (the following day).

This is the [second](#) notice of the application.

The objection period is deemed to commence from [Wednesday, 27 February 2008](#).

Pursuant to Section 47F(2) of the *Liquor Act* an objection may only be made on the ground that the grant of the licence may or will adversely affect:

- (a) the amenity of the neighbourhood where the premises the subject of the application are or will be located; or
- (b) health, education, public safety or social conditions in the community.

Only those persons, organisations or groups described in Section 47F(3) of the *Liquor Act* may make an objection. Section 47G of the *Liquor Act* requires the Director of Licensing to inform the applicant of the substance of any objection. This will include the identity and where relevant the address of the objector. Objections to this application should be lodged in writing with the Director of Licensing within thirty (30) days of the commencement date of the objection period.
