In consideration of the Licensing Commission granting this application to register the greyhound described below, I agree to be bound by and to comply with all such rules and statutory provisions in respect of Greyhound Racing and the registration of greyhounds as shall for the time being and from time to time be in force and be made by the said Commission and all directions and decisions that shall from time to time be made thereunder by the Commission or by any other authority or person authorised under such rules to make the same.

NOTE: Where the applicant is not owner or lessee of greyhound, an authority to register services per Form B must be lodged with the Licensing Commission.

I further agree that as a condition of registration and retention of registration that:

- (a) The number of bitches to be served by the greyhound which is the subject of this application shall not exceed 14 in number in any one calendar month.
- (b) That if the greyhound referred to in this application shall fail to produce 10 litters from each 20 bitches served (and in this regard I acknowledge that the Commission may if it wishes rely solely upon whelping notices received by it), that I shall, within seven (7) days of receiving notice from the Commission present the said greyhound to a professional person or persons at such place and for such period specified by the Commission so that veterinary tests may be carried out on the dog.
- (c) That I will accept responsibility for payment of any veterinary fees incurred by a direction of the Commission in relation to fertility testing of the greyhound referred to in the schedule.
- (d) That if the results of the tests referred to in the preceding clause (b) are not to the satisfaction of the Commission (and in this regard I agree that no reasons need be given for such dissatisfaction), then the said Commission shall have the unqualified right to suspend the Stud registration of the greyhound by notification to me for a period not being longer than one (1) month and at the end of the period specified, I shall submit the dog to further tests as required by the Commission.
- (e) If the Commission is not satisfied with the results of such further tests, it may suspend the stud registration of the said greyhound for such period as it thinks fit or indefinitely and thereafter the onus shall be on me to show that the greyhound can perform its stud duties in a proper manner.
- (f) The Commission shall have the unrestricted right to publish the number of services by the said greyhound and the number of litters produced from such services.
- (g) Any reference to the "Commission" in this document shall be construed so as to include its Chairman, its Stewards and/or its other proper officers.
- (h) Any notification given to me may be sent by ordinary pre-paid post to my present address or to such other address as I may from time to time advise in writing.

RACING & BETTING ACT - GREYHOUNDS
NOTICE IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE INFORMATION ACT
(INFORMATION PRIVACY PRINCIPLE 1)

Racing, Gaming and Licensing (RGL – a division of NT Treasury) is seeking information from you for the purposes of greyhound racing.

Information Privacy Principle 1 (IPP 1) requires that a public sector organisation must not collect personal information unless the information is necessary for one or more of its functions or activities. If personal information about an individual is collected from the individual, the organisation must take reasonable steps to ensure that the individual is aware of certain matters. For the purposes of IPP 1, the following advice is provided.

- You are able to access your personal information that you have provided by making a written request to the Director of Licensing.
- The information is required pursuant to the Racing and Betting Act.
- The information will be kept confidential except as follows:
 - (a) Details may be released to the Darwin Greyhound Association, the race caller, and interstate greyhound control boards or authorities.
 - (b) Registers will be maintained and details concerning a greyhound trainer will be made available to members of the public, on request.
- You do not have to provide information if you do not wish to do so. However:
 - (a) an application may not be approved if there is insufficient information to properly determine the matter in accordance with the Act.
 - (b) failure to give a notification may preclude the dog owner and/or dog from participating in greyhound racing.
