**2nd NOTICE OF APPLICATION FOR A SUBSTITUTION OF
LIQUOR LICENSED PREMISES**

AND

**VARIATION TO LICENCE CONDITIONS
(AUTHORITY 'RESTAURANT' TO AUTHORITY 'ON LICENCE')**

THE HANUMAN THAI RESTAURANT

I, KEN FRENCH, ON BEHALF OF SHUTAN PTY LTD, HEREBY GIVE NOTICE that I have applied to the Northern Territory Licensing Commission for a substitution and variation of the premises from which liquor is sold under a Restaurant Liquor Licence (number 80503046), currently known as The Hanuman Thai Restaurant located at Shop 1/28 Mitchell Street Darwin.

- Currently:- Liquor shall only be sold for consumption ancillary to a meal between the hours of 11:30 to 02:00 the next day, 7 days a week, at Shop 1/28 Mitchell Street Darwin 0800.
- Substitution sought is to relocate the restaurant to a premises to be known as The Hanuman Thai Restaurant located at 93 Mitchell Street Darwin NT 0800
- Variation sought is to amend the type of licence from Authority 'Restaurant' to Authority 'On Licence'. This will allow liquor to be served to patrons without the requirement of a meal and for patrons to be seated on bar stools at the bar area. Snack foods will be available at all times. The times of service of liquor will remain unchanged. The new premises will allow seating for 160 patrons, 80 within the confines of the building and 80 patrons within an Alfresco Dining area.

This is the second notice of application.

The objection period is deemed to commence from Wednesday 8 August, 2007.

Pursuant to Section 47F(2) of the *Liquor Act* an objection may only be made on the ground that the substitution of licensed premises may or will adversely affect:

- (a) the amenity of the neighbourhood where the premises the subject of the application are or will be located; or
- (b) health, education, public safety or social conditions in the community.

Only those persons, organisations or groups described in Section 47F (3) of the *Liquor Act* may make an objection. Section 47G of the *Liquor Act* requires the Director of Licensing to inform the applicant of the substance of any objection. This will include the identity and where relevant the address of the objector.
