ALCOHOL IN EAST ARNHEM

WHAT YOU NEED TO KNOW ABOUT PERMITS

A Territory Government initiative

You need an Alcohol Permit to buy, possess and drink takeaway alcohol within the East Arnhem Region, including the township of Nhulunbuy.

The Permit will contain a number of conditions, including a ban on drinking in many public places within Nhulunbuy and the East Arnhem area.

The introduction of Alcohol Permits is one of a number of initiatives to address the serious alcohol related issues within the region.

To obtain a permit you will need to provide:

- a letter of residency from a local resident, employer or the accommodation where

you are staying; and

- photo identification eg. a Northern Territory, Interstate or International Driver's Licence, 18+ card or Passport.

You do not need a permit to drink alcohol in any of the East Arnhem hotels, clubs and restaurants.
