ALCOHOL IN KATHERINE WHAT YOU NEED TO KNOW

Welcome to Katherine.

We'd like your stay to be as enjoyable as possible.

To that end, we have certain measures to help reduce alcohol-related harm in Katherine. These rules apply to everyone in Katherine.

Public Restricted Areas

Drinking alcohol in any public place within the Katherine Town boundary is banned and attracts penalties. This means you can't drink alcohol in parks, on the banks of the Katherine River, in car parks and at Knotts Crossing.

You can still drink in private residences and at pubs, clubs and restaurants. Some special community events also may be licensed to allow drinking.

While you're here please respect our ways.

Liquor Supply Plan

This plan works hand-in-hand with other supply reduction measures. The main elements of this plan include, among other things:

- Takeaway sales only allowed
Weekdays
2pm – 8pm
Saturday and public holidays
12 noon – 8pm
Sunday (Hotels only)
2pm – 8pm
- Sale of cask and fortified wine limited to one 2 litre cask or one bottle of fortified wine per person per day, between the hours of 2pm and 6pm.
- Before midday you can only drink light beer at licensed premises.

Photo ID System

Everyone must present photo ID when buying alcohol from licensed

takeaway outlets in Katherine, Mataranka, Pine Creek or Victoria River Roadhouse.

Your ID will be scanned to ensure you are not buying more alcohol than the rules allow. Acceptable forms of ID include:

- Driver's licence
- Passport
- Proof of age card.

The system also recognises national identity cards from over 50 countries.

Nitmiluk National Park has special Australian Government alcohol restrictions. Before visiting the park go to www.fahcsia.gov.au/nter or visit the Katherine Tourist Information Centre.
