Change of Manager

What Does This Process Allow Me To Do?

Individuals, registered companies or partnerships applying for a Liquor Licence are required to identify one person as the nominated Manager or Nominee. The Nominee is the person responsible for the day to day management of the licensed premises.

This process allows the licensee to legally change the person nominated as manager of licensed premises. This situation generally arises because of staff turnover.

Are There Any Special Conditions Or Restrictions?

The Nominee must be a person of good character, preferably with relevant experience, and must comply with a range of standard conditions identified on the relevant forms.

What Is The Process?

Before applying, consider the willingness of the proposed Nominee to undergo a police check and to provide all supporting information required.

Territory Business Centres provide relevant application forms and the Authority to Release Criminal History form. Completed forms must be accompanied by supporting information which includes:

- details of any previous charges, offences or convictions
- business and personal references
- profile of previous work experience
- other details concerning the Nominee and the premises.

Do I Need Any Special Knowledge, Experience Or Training?

The Nominee must successfully complete a Responsible Service of Alcohol course. The course takes about half a day to complete. Its primary purpose is to ensure that nominees are aware of responsible serving practices and to assist in discouraging the irresponsible, or excessive consumption and supply of liquor within the Northern Territory.

The Nominee must also successfully complete a *Liquor Act* test. This requires familiarity with a number of sections of the Act identified on a list issued with application forms. While Nominees are not expected to memorise the Act, they are expected to be familiar with sections that apply to the proposed licensed premises.

The Nominee is also expected to be aware of, and to comply with, the Industry Code of Practice to Assist in Responsible Alcohol Promotion.
