



Events and Functions in Tennant Creek

From 1 August 2008 no-one can drink alcohol in public in Tennant Creek.

However, special occasions can still be celebrated with alcohol as long as you have a special event permit.

Special Event Permits

These can be obtained by the organisers of public festivals, community and sporting events, weddings, fundraising activities, street parties and similar functions.

The organisers of special events can apply to the Licensing Commission for a permit that allows alcohol to be consumed in a public restricted area during the event or function.

Permits will not be granted to minors.
