Application to Conduct a Trade Lottery

Conditions for the Conduct of a Trade Lottery

1. Entrants shall be advised of all conditions of entry.
2. Entitlement to accept a preferred prize shall not depend upon payment of money or some other form of valuable consideration.
3. Entry coupons shall be free of charge. (This does not preclude the need to purchase an item to qualify for an entry where lottery is secondary to the commercial transaction and occurs after the transaction)
4. Entry into a lottery shall not depend upon multiple purchases of a product or service unless that fact is predominantly displayed at the point of sale, on the product itself and on all promotion material. (This does not preclude lotteries which allow entry to a different level of prizes for multiple purchases)
5. Entry forms shall not be distributed in contravention of any *Act*, By-law, Regulation or Rule.
6. If the Prize is travel the following details shall be in the conditions of entry: destination; number of people; duration; accommodation; meals; valid until; subject to availability; peak period; spending money; redeemable for cash or transferable.
7. Prize not available directly to Northern Territory winners shall be detailed in the conditions of entry.
8. The place, date and time of the promotion shall be detailed in the conditions of entry.
9. Results shall be published in a publication readily available to Northern Territory entrants.
10. Trade lotteries shall not have prizes that include tobacco. Any alcohol component of a prize offered shall not represent a principal part of that prize.
11. Each and every entry shall have an equal probability of winning and the lottery shall be determined solely by chance.
12. In the event of any dispute, complaint or investigation concerning the conduct or outcome of a lottery, it shall be the sole responsibility of the permit holder, at the permit holder's cost, to demonstrate compliance with these conditions to the reason satisfaction of the Director of Licensing.
13. Copies of entry forms, pamphlets, advertising etc., must be lodged with this application.
14. Forms must be lodged at Territory Business Centres at least 5 working days prior to the commencement of going to print.

Gaming Machine Act

Notice In Accordance with the Information Act (Information Privacy Principle 1)

Licensing, Regulation and Alcohol Strategy (LRAS – a division of NT Department of Justice) is seeking information from you for the purposes of your application.

Information Privacy Principle 1 (IPP 1) requires that a public sector organisation must not collect personal information unless the information is necessary for one or more of its functions or activities. If personal information about an individual is collected from the individual, the organisation must take reasonable steps to ensure that the individual is aware of certain matters. For the purposes of IPP 1, the following advice is provided.

- a) You are able to access your personal information that you have provided by making a written request to the Director of Licensing.
- b) The information is required pursuant to the *Gaming Control Act*. The Act requires that certain matters must be considered when deciding whether or not to approve an application.
- c) The information will be kept confidential except as follows:
 - i. Information may be sought from Police, government agencies, interstate licensing authorities, or referees or other persons nominated by you. Information may be released to those sources to the extent necessary to verify information about you and your application.
 - ii. If a hearing is involved, information will be released to the parties, Commission or the Court, as required by the Act.
 - iii. Registers of licences and permits will be maintained and may be made available to the public on request.
- d) You do not have to provide information if you do not wish to do so. However, an application may not be approved if there is insufficient information to properly determine the matter in accordance with the Act.
