POLICY TITLE: PAYMENT OF REGISTRATION FEE

Purpose of Policy:

The application fee for registration as a building practitioner is \$800 for two years. For applicants applying under Mutual Recognition the fee of \$800 is paid upon application including a non-refundable application fee of \$200 and if not approved \$600 will be refunded. For all other applicants this fee consists of a non-refundable \$200 fee to be paid upon application and a further \$600 fee to be paid once the Board has assessed the applicant as suitable for registration.

This policy outlines the administrative process which will be followed (for all applications not lodged under mutual recognition) once the Board has assessed an applicant as suitable for registration in order for a Certificate of Registration to issue.

Policy:

When an application for registration or renewal of registration has been assessed as meeting all registration requirements, the following procedure will apply:

The applicant will be advised in writing:

- That they have been assessed as suitable for registration;
- The date by which the remaining \$600 fee must be paid (two months from the date of the meeting);
- A registration certificate will be issued on receipt of the \$600 payment;
- Registration will be for a period of two years;
- In the case of new registrations, registration will be effective from the date payment is received;
- In the case of renewals, registration will be effective from the renewal date (provided the application was lodged prior to expiry of their registration);
- Practitioners should advise the Board as soon as possible if there are circumstances which prevent them paying the \$600 fee by the due date;
- Should there be no response from the applicant by the due date, the Board may determine that the application has lapsed.
