INTERIM DEVELOPMENT CONTROL ORDER

I, MICHAEL JAMES PALMER, the Minister for Lands, Planning and Environment, in pursuance of section 10(1) of the *Planning Act*, having formed the intention to prepare a proposed control plan in respect of the land shown bounded by thick black lines and numbered "I.D.C.O. No. 4" on the map in Schedule 1, make the interim development control order specified in Schedule 2 and specify that the order is to remain in force for the period of 12 months on and from the date on which this order is notified in the *Gazette*.

SCHEDULE 2

INTERIM DEVELOPMENT CONTROL ORDER No. 4

(a) Development of -

a building containing one dwelling ("detached dwelling"); or

a building, or a group of buildings on a site, containing more than one dwelling each of which has a separate entrance at ground level ("cluster dwellings"),

on land within the area shown bounded by thick black lines and numbered "I.D.C.O. No. 4" on the map in Schedule 1, may only proceed with the consent, under Part 7 of the *Planning Act*, of the consent authority.

(b) The Minister is the consent authority for the purposes of an application for consent for development specified in paragraph (a).
