The Museum and Art Gallery Northern Territory (MAGNT) is inviting applications for the George Chaloupka Fellowship.

In honour of Rock Art Historian, Emeritus Curator Dr George Chaloupka OAM FAHA, MAGNT with financial assistance raised by the MAGNT Foundation has established the George Chaloupka Fellowship. The Fellowship aims to promote and support research and conservation of Aboriginal rock art located in Arnhem Land Plateau region in the Northern Territory of Australia.

The 2011 fellowship is funded by Energy Resources of Australia Pty Ltd.

The Fellowship of \$25,000 will be granted to an individual to undertake work in one or more of the following areas:

- Pursuing the recording / data collection of rock art sites in Arnhem Land Plateau region in areas not yet surveyed through the work of Emeritus Curator Dr George Chaloupka OAM FAHA or other researchers
- Interpretation of sites by custodians / traditional owners
- Preservation of rock art
- Dating of rock art
- Researching / documenting the work of Emeritus Curator Dr George Chaloupka OAM FAHA held at MAGNT
