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BY-LAW 13 – PHOTOGRAPHY/FILMING PERMIT APPLICATION

(Please allow 5 working days to process this permit)

Territory Parks and Wildlife Conservation By-Laws

(Trade and Commerce - Photography/Filming)

Pursuant to By-law 13 of the *Territory Parks and Wildlife Conservation By-laws*, the Parks and Wildlife Commission of the Northern Territory ("the Commission") hereby grants to the party specified herein as the Permit Holder a permit to engage in trade and commerce by conducting the activity in the Park or Reserve specified herein subject to the payment of the fee or royalty and subject to the conditions specified herein:

CONDITIONS

The Permit Holder shall comply with all the terms and conditions which appear on the reverse side of this Permit. A Certificate of Currency will need to be provided prior to the issuing of the Permit (as per Condition 2 (a) and (b)).

If you wish to undertake aerial filming or photography you are required to obtain a By-Law 32 Permit.

The Permit Holder shall provide a copy of the end production to the Executive Director of Parks for internal educational purposes only within NRETAS.

SPECIAL CONDITIONS – FOR NATIONAL PARKS AND RESERVES

- LITCHFIELD NATIONAL PARK

- Filming and broadcasting to air video footage and / or publishing of any still photos of people or persons jumping or diving off rocks into the water is prohibited.

- NITMILUK NATIONAL PARK

- The Ranger in charge must be notified at least 5 days prior to commencement of filming, Phone: (08) 8972 1886.
- The Permit Holders must be available for a pre commencement briefing on site with a Senior Ranger to discuss appropriate locations and images.
- A Park Ranger may be required to accompany the crew during filming at the Permit Holders expense (\$55/hr). This will help ensure that only appropriate footage and promotion of the Park ensues and will avoid unduly disturbing or diminishing other visitor's enjoyment of the Park.
- Permit Holder's vehicle must remain on sealed roads at all times whilst in the Park.
- Permit Holder must remain on designated walking tracks at all times whilst in the Park unless prior arrangements have been made with the Chief District Ranger or delegate and are indicated on permit conditions.
- Filming and photography is restricted to those parts of the park accessible to the general public.
- No filming/photography shall depict any person/s in breach of By-Laws or undertaking prohibited activities.
- Permits will be issued for a maximum of 6 months only.

- WATARRKA NATIONAL PARK

- In some instances the Permit Holders may need to be available for a briefing with a Senior Ranger. A Park Ranger may be required to accompany the crew during filming at Permit Holders expense (\$55/hr). This will help ensure that only appropriate footage and promotion of the Park ensues and will avoid unduly disturbing or diminishing other visitor's enjoyment of the Park. - Permit Holder's vehicle must remain on sealed roads at all times whilst in the Park.
- Permit Holder must remain on designated walking tracks at all times whilst in the Park unless prior arrangements have been made with the Chief District Ranger or delegate and are indicated on permit conditions.
- Filming and photography is restricted to those parts of the park accessible to the general public.
- No filming/photography shall depict actors or subjects in any dangerous situation or position, including keeping all film subjects at least 1.5 meters from any cliff edge.

- WEST MACDONNELLS NATIONAL PARK

- Restricted to Public access road/tracks to gain access to any areas. Contact the Ranger in Charge, Simpsons Gap (08) 8955 0310 or Ormiston Gorge (08) 8956 7799.

- DEVILS MARBLES CONSERVATION RESERVE

- Permission is granted to the Permit Holder to film/photograph in the general public areas only; access to other areas within the Reserve is not permitted.
- Be aware of areas where filming/photography are not permitted – see attached map.

- CHAMBERS PILLAR HISTORICAL RESERVE

- The Permit Holder is required to ensure the experience of other park users is not diminished by any activity associated with filming activities.
- Filming or photographing is NOT permitted of Castle Rock.

- RAINBOW VALLEY CONSERVATION RESERVE

- Permission is granted to the Permit Holder to film/photograph in the general public areas only; access to other areas within the Reserve is not permitted:-
 - The Rocky Bluff of Rainbow Valley should not be climbed or accessed.
 - Filming south of the walking track is not permitted.
- Access to the claypans is not permitted:-
 - Applications can be submitted to gain limited access on foot only, for special purposes only.
 - Applications must be submitted well in advance or will not be considered.
 - Conditions apply to claypan access and Permit Holder must be accompanied by a Ranger or Traditional Owner.
- Permit applications must state the intended use of the images to be taken and images may only be used for the purposes stated on the permit, if granted.

- The Ranger in charge must be notified at least 5 days prior to commencement of filming. Call (08) 8952 1013.

- **EMILY & JESSIE GAPS**

- Permit Holder to ensure they film/photograph Emily and Jessie Gaps only on the outside at the southern end. Please do not film/photograph on the inside of the Gaps.

- **TNORALA (GOSSE BLUFF)**

- Permission is not granted to film at Tnorala (Gosse Bluff) Conservation Reserve.

CONDITIONS

In consideration of the Commission granting to the Permit Holder a By-law 13 Permit the Permit Holder hereby agrees as follows:

1. The Permit Holder enters the Park/Reserve entirely at his/her own risk and the Commission and the Conservation Land Corporation ("the Corporation") accept no liability whatsoever for any loss, damage, injury of whatsoever nature to the Permit Holder or to any other person arising as a result of or in any way connected with the presence of the Permit Holder at the Park or Reserve.
2. The Permit Holder shall:
 - (a) indemnify, and keep indemnified the Corporation, the Northern Territory of Australia ("the Territory"), the Commission and its employees and agents against all claims, demands, loss or damage to property or injury to or death to any person arising as a result of or in connection with:
 - (i) the breach by the Permit Holder or the neglect or failure of the Permit Holder to observe or perform and fulfil any of the conditions contained herein; or
 - (ii) the conduct of activity by the Permit Holder while on the Park or Reserve.
 - (iii) the presence of the Permit Holder at the Park or Reserve.
 - (b) (i) effect and keep effected a comprehensive "all risks" liability policy inclusive of public liability and claims arising out of this Permit extended to include the Commission in any single event not less than ten million dollars (\$10,000,000) which policy shall be endorsed to include the indemnity given by the Permit Holder herein.
 - (ii) provide evidence to the Commission that such insurance has been effected.
 - (c) if so directed by the Commission, reimburse the Commission for any cost of search or rescue incurred by the Commission arising out of or in connection with the conduct of the activity or the presence of the Permit Holder on the Park or Reserve.
 - (d) comply with all regulations or rules made by the Commission and all Statutes, By-laws and Regulations in force in the Northern Territory in respect of the Park or Reserve.
 - (e) not drive nor permit to be driven any vehicle within the Park or Reserve other than on the designated roads or on such other areas as the Ranger-in-Charge or the Commission may approve.
 - (f) ensure that nothing is left in the Park or Reserve which, in the opinion of the Commission, may constitute a fire hazard, health hazard or a danger to persons, plants or animals.
 - (g) not light any fires nor permit any fires to be lit other than in portable stoves or Commission approved fireplaces or as otherwise approved by the Ranger in Charge.
 - (h) obey all reasonable directions given by an officer of the Commission.
 - (i) not do nor permit to be done anything in the Park or Reserve which is noisome, offensive or a nuisance or annoyance to other users of the Park or Reserve.

- (j) make good any damage of whatsoever nature and howsoever occurring to the Park or Reserve which results from the activity or the presence of the Permit Holder on the Park or Reserve. If the Permit Holder fails to make good such damage to the satisfaction of the Commission then the Commission may cause to have the damage repaired and may recover the costs of so doing from the Permit Holder as a debt due to the Commission.
 - (k) ensure the Commission is acknowledged in any publication which results from or is in any way connected with the granting of this Permit.
 - (l) contact Ranger-in-Charge five days before commencing activities on the Park or Reserve. Failure to do so may result in delays in carrying out filming activities.**
 - (m) carry this Permit at all times while on the Park or Reserve.
3. This Permit shall not confer upon the Permit Holder or the Participants the exclusive right to possession of the whole or any part of the Park or Reserve.
 4. This Permit shall be automatically revoked by the Commission if in the opinion of the Commission any of the above conditions are breached by the Permit Holder.
