COMMUNITY CABINET IN TIMBER CREEK AND YARRALIN

Northern Territory Ministers will take Community Cabinet to Timber Creek and Yarralin on Monday June 5 and Tuesday June 6.

Chief Minister Clare Martin said Ministers will meet with the residents over the two days.

“This is all about taking the Government out of Darwin and listening to the views of locals,” Ms Martin said.

“It also provides the opportunity to unveil a \$100,000 makeover at one of the Territory’s most historical pastoral stations.”

Chief Minister Clare Martin and Environment and Heritage Minister Marion Scrymgour will open the renovated Bullita Homestead and Stockyard.

More than \$100,000 has been spent to transform the homestead which is located within Gregory National Park along the Victoria Highway.

Chief Minister Clare Martin will also host a Women’s Forum in Timber Creek on Monday.

Minister for Employment, Education and Training Syd Stirling will donate a set of reading and reference books during his visits to Timber Creek and Yarralin schools.

“I am pleased to hand over these valuable learning tools to students,” Mr Stirling said.

“Literacy and numeracy for all Territory students remains a key priority for the Territory Government.”

Government Ministers will hold their Cabinet meeting in Yarralin on Tuesday.
