### Free Science Week Film Festival on at MAGNT

The Museum & Art Gallery of the Northern Territory proudly presents Scinema06 as part of National Science Week 2006.

Australia's only travelling science film festival Scinema06, will explore the latest collaborations between science, film and art.

MAGNT Discovery Centre acting manager Natalie Jenkins said that audiences can view six great programs from across the globe on subjects ranging from Maths, Physics and Astronomy, Inventions and Discoveries to Wildlife at Risk and State of the Planet.

"The program is free and will give people a chance to view science films that explain and explore the world around them," she said.

"The films have been selected for their broad ranging topics that relate to the main theme of 'Think about the Future'.
