Mr Traynor said visitors will be able to get into the spirit of things with free Aussie tattoos, zinc cream and lollies for all the kids.

"People dressed in "Aussie Clobber" will also receive raffle tickets to go into the draw to win an Aussie Adventure Pack on the day," Mr Traynor said.

"The pack includes a Coleman's inflatable kayak, snorkelling set, books and more."

"A sausage sizzle will also be available for purchase for \$2.50 or \$4 for a sausage and soft drink combo."
