Top End Attractions Close Due To Rain

Recent heavy rain south of Darwin has forced the closure of the Douglas River/Daly River Esplanade Conservation Area and Tjuwalyin (Douglas) Hot Springs Park.

Northern Territory Parks and Wildlife Service Chief District Ranger John McCartney said dirt tracks providing access to both popular attractions, 200km south of Darwin, would remain closed until the end of the wet season.

The private Douglas/Daly Park on the Ooloo road remains open.
