### **Florence Falls Reopened at Litchfield National Park**

The Northern Territory Parks and Wildlife Service advises that Florence Falls at Litchfield National Park has reopened to swimming following its closure on Saturday.

Chief District Ranger John McCartney said other swimming spots, including Wangi Falls and Buley Rock Hole, remain closed for swimming, however, people can visit and enjoy viewing the falls and using the facilities there.

“Buley Rock Hole remains closed due to turbulence in the water which could make swimming unsafe for visitors, Mr McCartney said.

Mr McCartney said access to the Park is still via Batchelor only.

He said other popular attractions such as Surprise Creek Falls, Sandy Creek Falls, Walker Creek, Bamboo Creek and the Lost City are also closed until further notice.
