Popular Attractions Reopen at Litchfield National Park

The Northern Territory Parks and Wildlife Service advises that Florence Falls and Buley Rock Hole have reopened to swimming at Litchfield National Park.

Chief District Ranger John McCartney said other swimming spots, including Wangi Falls, remain closed for swimming, however, people can visit and enjoy viewing the falls and using the facilities there.

Mr McCartney said access to the Park is still via Batchelor only.

He said other popular attractions such as Surprise Creek Falls, Sandy Creek Falls, Walker Creek, Bamboo Creek and the Lost City are also closed until further notice.
