Northern Territory Parks and Wildlife Service rangers and Northern Territory Police yesterday responded to a call for help after a man experienced difficulties while in the water at Florence Falls in Litchfield National Park.

The 58-year-old man was visiting the popular tourist attraction with his wife late yesterday and died while in the water.

Northern Territory Police will be conducting an autopsy to determine the cause of death and a file will be prepared for the coroner.

PWS northern region director David West urged the public to exercise care and caution when swimming at Litchfield National Park.
