Popular Hot Springs Open

The NT Parks and Wildlife Service advise that Tjuwaliyn (Douglas) Hot Springs Park is now open for visitors.

The park was closed in January due to heavy rains during the wet season that caused road closures.

Buley Rock Hole and Florence Falls at Litchfield National Park are open for swimming, while Wangi Falls is open for viewing, but remains closed to swimming.

The road beyond Douglas Hot Springs to Butterfly Gorge is still closed.

The Park is owned by the Wagiman people who jointly manage it with Parks and Wildlife and visitors are reminded to observe all safety signs and respect sacred places while visiting the parks.

The public is advised to refer to the website below and phone ahead before planning a trip to parks and reserves in the Darwin region.
