



# Natural Resource Management Board (NT) Inc.

## \$1000 Up for Grabs in NT Landcare Awards

The Natural Resource Management Board (NT) Inc. is now calling for nominations in the 16th prestigious Northern Territory Landcare Awards worth \$1000 each.

Natural Resource Management Board (NT) Inc. Deputy Chairman Jim Forwood said the awards recognise the efforts of individuals, community groups, indigenous communities and organisations.

Mr Forwood urged landcarers, including those who have received or applied for Natural Heritage Trust (NHT) funding, to nominate for the awards.

“We are looking Territory wide to reward landcarers for their efforts in sustainable land management and environmental management, with a cash prize of \$1000,” Mr Forwood said.

“Individuals and groups involved in community landcare can nominate in one of 11 categories that cover work protecting individual farms, rivers, coastal environments, threatened species, local government areas, fire management and even whole catchments.

“The Landcare Awards are a great chance to highlight the hard work and dedication of volunteers working to protect the Territory’s precious natural resources.

“It is vital that our volunteers, who work tirelessly across the country in sometimes difficult environments, are recognised for their dedication and success.”

Mr Forwood said winners from each category will receive a trophy and a cash prize of \$1000.

“All NT winners excluding the local category winner (Bushfires NT Fire Management Award), also automatically go on to become finalists in the 2008 National Landcare Awards, to be held at Parliament House in Canberra 2008,” Mr Forwood said.

“Finalists can select two representatives to be flown to Canberra to attend the gala dinner and ceremony and the national winner will receive a further cash prize of \$1000.”

Groups or individuals in the NT can nominate for 2007 NT Landcare Awards in the following 11 categories:

- Alcoa Landcare Community Group Award
- Australian Government Coastcare Award
- Australian Government Landcare NRM Region Award
- Bushfires NT Fire Management Award (Local Category)
- National Landcare Programme Individual Landcare Award
- Landcare Australia Nature Conservation Award
- Leighton Holdings Local Government Landcare Partnerships Award
- Murray-Darling Basin Commission Rivercare Award
- Rural Press Landcare Primary Producer Award
- Westpac Landcare Education Award
