Funky Monkey Mornings at the Territory Wildlife Park

Come and join the Amazing Drumming Monkeys for their Funky Monkey Mornings at the Territory Wildlife Park these school holidays.

These dynamic entertainers were a big hit at the various markets around town last year and the park has booked them to perform a 30 minute variety show daily from 25 June to 15 July.

The two monkeys Bongo and Congo play African and Latino style hand drums and percussion, sing inspirational songs and perform magic tricks.
