## **Nominations for Northern Territory Register of Peers**

Territory artists and arts workers, including volunteer Board and Committee members are being encouraged to nominate for the Northern Territory Register of Peers.

Arts NT Key Initiatives Manager Ms Hania Radvan said the Northern Territory Register of Peers is an advisory body and open to all those interested and experienced in arts and culture who would like to be involved in the development of arts in the Territory.

“Nominations are accepted all year round with an annual review to ensure currency of information,” Ms Radvan said.

“The register aims to form an official pool of specialists and peers that may be called upon to advise the Arts Grant Board on particular project applications and Government through working parties drawn together to address particular topics/issues.

“Members may also be asked to participate in assessment panels for special initiatives.

“We’re especially interested in trying to broaden the current register to include Indigenous members, as well as members from music, literature, craft and dance backgrounds.

“Its important to have members from all these artistic communities to ensure the register is able to reflect the broad scope of arts interests within the community.”
