The George Brown Darwin Botanic Gardens has been closed for visitors today due to the recent wet weather.

Botanic Gardens manager Dave Griffiths said two of their big trees have come down because of the wet weather and are currently blocking pathways.

“The soil is also considerably wet and in the interests of public safety they want to be sure that further trees do not fall before re-opening the Botanic Gardens,” Mr Griffiths said.

“In addition, the trees blocking the pathways need to be cleared and removed before they can be safely used again.”
