Statement from MAGNT Director Anna Malgorzewicz

The Museum and Art Gallery of the Northern Territory (MAGNT) today commenced a review of its security operations and a risk assessment following yesterday's break-in which resulted in seven Indigenous artworks being stolen.

MAGNT Director Anna Malgorzewicz confirmed the artworks, which were recovered within hours in nearby bushland, had an estimated value of at least \$500,000.

"Again I want to thank the Northern Territory Police, in their quick response and assistance in recovering the pieces for the Museum," Ms Malgorzewicz said.

"The review will be ongoing over the coming weeks.

"As the theft of the artworks is now before the courts MAGNT will be providing no further comment to allow the judicial process to take its course."
